- NEXT helps to support education, job training, services, and support
- NEXT assists youths with employment all in one place
- NEXT is available for youth ages 16-24 in Clark County
- NEXT can provide bus passes as well as they have coffee and do not put pressure on youth who want to visit their site
- "Opportunity Youth" are youth who are the biggest opportunity for our community. They are not in school and not working (or working but not enough to provide for themselves)
- They also help support non-English speaking youth and help them get to a place where they can be successful
- NEXT has orientation every Thursday at 4pm, then youth have individual appointments with an advisor to help find youth talents and how to generalize skills into the real world
- There is a shower on site, food is provided, mental health services are referred to, mentoring is being developed

- Other programs through NEXT include Open Doors Program, Clark College transitional studies, Connections with local high schools, Alternative high school and GED options, paid internships (200 hours up to \$3000), resume building, workforce classes, mock interviewing, networking, community service, and worksite tours
- There are sector-focused trainings such as manufacturing, technology, construction, and healthcare
