### **SWOT Analysis and Needs Assessment**

- Each year, all FYSPRTs across Washington State use a tool of their choice to identify the strengths and opportunities for growth in their Region's youth system of care.
- SWWA FYSPRT uses SWOT analysis. SWOT stands for strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats.
- Tri-Leads led attendees in a guided activity using Kahoot to see what strengths and weakness could be kept, needed modifying, or could be removed.
- Goal of Needs Assessment is to then help in creating the Workplan; the Workplan is used to guide the SWWA FYSPRTs activities, events, and projects for the coming year.
