Key Discussion Points:

1. Free Family Activities:

• Suggested free family activities including the Thrive to Survive event on Labor Day, Camas Farmers Market, events at Vancouver waterfront, and Mount Tabor Raves in Portland.

2. Discussion: Identify recurring gaps and needs related to inadequate inpatient behavioral health services

- Discussion about the lack of child and adolescent inpatient psychiatric services in Northeast Washington, particularly following a major center closure in Spokane.
- Emphasis on the need for improved communication and coordination among services for youth in crisis.
- Concerns over lengthy wait times and lack of resources contributing to negative impacts on families and youth.
- Increased dependency on law enforcement during mental health crises due to the absence of adequate local services.

3. Only7Seconds Presentation by Luke Wall:

- Emphasized the impact of relationships and social interactions on health and well-being.
- Organization's focus includes community engagement, education, and youth-led programming.
- Stressed the importance of strengthening social support systems and reaching out to improve well-being.

4. Meeting Conclusion:

- Open discussion on the effects of insufficient services and collaborative solutions.
- Plans for future meetings and a potentially collaborative session with Luke Wall.
