

Meeting Minutes: SWWA REGIONAL FYSPRT Meeting
6/16/2025 Hybrid River City Church- Vancouver WA

Updates from WISe Services:

- Youth and family cases on service list decreased to 80 from 102 last year.
- "WISe" teams increased from 19 to 33, with notable increases in families served.
- Additional staff updates and hiring details shared.

Presentation on Catholic Community Services Access Now Program:

- Created to address long waitlists for "WISe" services.
- Focus on crisis safety planning and medication management.

Discussion Points:

Access Team Engagement:

- Virtual telehealth noted for better child engagement.
- Streamlined intake process for quicker service access.
- Average wait for WISe services around six months.
- Access provides interim support.
- No-show policy impacts service transition decisions.
- Services capped at 90-120 days, with possible extension to 150 days.
- Funding and workforce availability hinder service expansion.

Community Activities and Events:

- Community events, resource fairs, and other activities planned.

Advocacy and Strategic Planning:

- Continuum of care initiative introduced; feedback requested.

Action Items:

- Distribute community event information.
- Continue client engagement assessments.
- Gather strategic planning feedback.
