Presentation:	<p>Janus Youth: Oak Bridge Youth Shelter Only homeless youth shelter in Vancouver, youth come from all over the state, our area is not just Vancouver, the next closest shelter north is Olympia to the coast none and east it is in Yakima. Youth as young as 9 until they age out of system at 18. It is very difficult for a teen to age out at the shelter. Take youth from all over referrals by school, law enforcement, and self-referral. The youth does want to be there and parent permission is required. They will attend school while in program. Transportation is set up through ESD112 but transportation is hard to find. They have chores while there. Even though they are a shelter/group home they are still residential. They can house up to 11 youth at one time, average age is 14-16, have 4-6 average at one time. Up to 75 days stay if programs combined. The shelter is available 24/7 and will take walk in pre-intakes. Burton neighborhood</p>

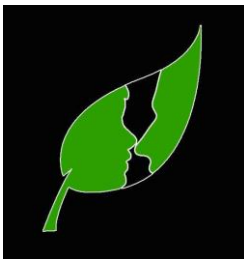
